

## CALVIA VILA - SON FONT - GALILEA

Start: Calvià Vila, Calle de Son Mir

Finish: Carretera de Es Capdellà, Galilea

Distance: 7.710 m

Altitude: 116 / 438 m

Estimated time required: 2 h

Difficulty: Easy/medium

Patrimonial elements: es Pou Nou (new well) of Son Font, barraca (shack) of Son Font, canal of Son Font, the ethnographic ensemble of Son Font, pozo (well) of capelleta of Son Font

Description: Path connecting Calvià and Galilea (Puigpunyent) villages, passing through the Son Font urbanisation. The route offers excellent views of the Calvià coastline and the 's'Esclop' and 'Puig de Galatzó' mountains. En route several ethnographic elements can be seen, such as water channels, water tanks, coal merchants' shacks, etc., whilst enjoying typical Mediterranean vegetation – wild olive trees, pine forests, oak trees, shrubs and fields of crops. This is a wonderful opportunity to get to know two historic areas, with examples of traditional Mallorcan architecture, such as are the villages of Calvià and Galilea.
