ROUTE FROM THE GR221 "ES CAPDELLÀ - ESTELLENCES"

This itinerary forms part of the variant "B" - named "Galatzó" - of the Grand Randonnée GR-221 hiking trail running from the Port d'Andratx to Pollença. The Pedra en Sec GR 221 route enables hikers to discover the drystone landscapes of the Serra de Tramuntana range.

The 16-km itinerary sets out from Es Capdellà, travelling along Carrer de Galatzó to the barrier of the Galatzó Public Estate, which it crosses to reach the stairway Botador de la Coma d'en Vidal. The GR221 continues to Estellencs, making it possible to visit interesting historical vestiges, discover myths and legends and get to know typical traditions of the Serra de Tramuntana. In regard to botanical wealth, the countless endemic plant species and the diversity of vegetation, with typically Mediterranean holm oak woods and shrublands, further increase the scenic interest of the route.

This route features the presence of numerous elements of great natural, ethnographic and scenic value, where visitors can discover the testimony of a past in which advantage was taken of every corner. The tithe grain store, the Casas de Galatzó, the lime kilns of Na Llaneres, the kiln of El Comellar de Ses Penyes Rotges, the ethnographic complex of Ses Sínies, the well of Ses Sínies and the Font des Poll fountain are elements and points of interest all along the route.
